HOW TO GET TO SZTAKI?

IF YOU TRAVEL BY PLANE, FROM (AND TO) THE AIRPORT WE SUGGEST THE COMFORTABLE AND RELIABLE SOLUTIONS BELOW.

SZTAKI has two main buildings under the following addresses:

[1111 Budapest, Kende utca 13-17.](#) - this is our main HQ building; this is where the symposium takes place

[1111 Lágymányosi utca 11.](#) - this is our second building, only a block away from HQ

- by cab from the accredited **[Főtaxi company](#)** (payment is possible both in cash and by card, pricing details at the link)
- via the **[mini-bus shuttle service](#)** (small group of travellers)
- by **[100E public bus-shuttle service](#)** providing a direct connection between Liszt Ferenc International Airport and Budapest city centre.
- Budapest has several car sharing providers as well, like **[GreenGo](#)** or **[Share Now](#)** – please note these providers may have different availability areas
- [Bolt](#)** is also available in Budapest – its an application-based taxi service mainly for short, sudden routes.

By train, you'll most probably arrive at the **[Keleti Railway station](#)**. From there, you can take a taxi or move on public transport (metro lines M2 and M4, point below). If you're heading to SZTAKI (M4), get off at "Móricz Zsigmond körtér" stop. From there, our institute is just 5–8-minute walk.

WHAT TO SEE AT SZTAKI?



INNOVATION AND DEMONSTRATION SPACE

An entire floor of robotics, autonomous systems, AI demonstrations and more; this recently opened co-working office focuses on the current scientific research areas of SZTAKI.



“FROM THE PAST TO THE FUTURE” HARDWARE EXHIBITION

An open exhibition showcasing some of the most important hardware developments of our institute, from the early 60s to the early 2000s, before our focus mainly turned to software development.



SMARTFACTORY

The SmartFactory is a compact, high-level but functional research and demonstration facility of SZTAKI which compresses a production site to the size of a single room.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Public transport just works great in Budapest (and across all Hungary).

If you plan to visit the city, then the best way to do it reliably and affordably is by public means of transport (buses, trams, [4 metro lines](#), suburban trains and boats).

Tickets and passes can be bought at any of the numerous [automated selling points](#), too. One of the best solutions might be to buy a 1- or 3-day pass. All options [here](#). ACCOMMODATION

There are several options to stay and feel welcomed in Budapest. Let us suggest a few, according to their location, convenient traffic options and services!

Hotel Mercure Budapest Castle Hill / Hotel Mercure Budapest Castle Hill

The two hotels take place in the same building, but they are different business entities. Nevertheless, both accommodations are close to the historical Castle District. Walking and shopping district of the city can be reached in few minutes. Tram 56A is a comfortable and fast way to get to the venue under 20 minutes.
